Guide to Heating / Cooling at The Memorial Hall

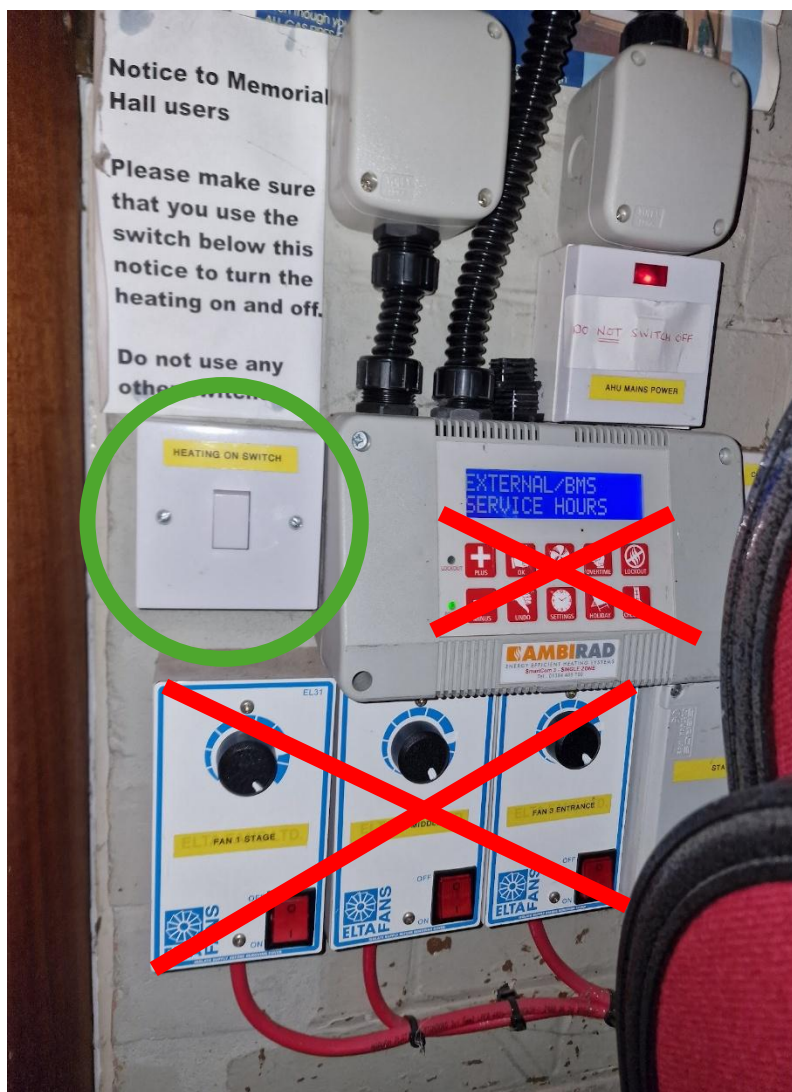
Main Hall

The main hall (and stage) is heated by a large natural-gas powered air blower. There is also a 'false' ceiling provided by rows of destratification fans blowing air back down from the ceiling. We recommend closing all doors to prevent draughts. The temperature to pre-set to 18.7°C and the thermostat will control the system accordingly, when the switch is on. (Overnight:12°C)

TO USE: Open the chair store door, on the wall to the left there is a light switched labelled "HEATING ON SWITCH" to the down position. The screen will display "EXTERNAL/BMS"

DO NOT alter any other setting or switch. There is no timer and the temperature has been preset.

Please remember to switch off again before you leave

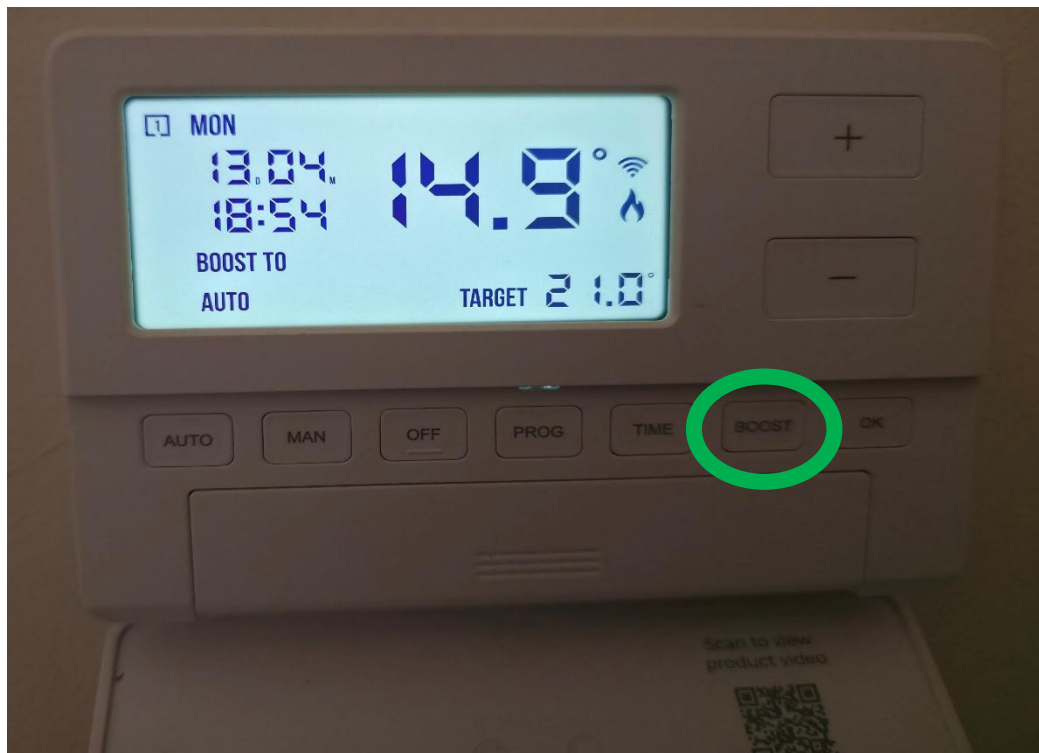


Entrance Lobby / Toilets

The entrance lobby / toilet area is heated by a Gas Combi boiler found in the kitchen; this also provides the hot water to the kitchen, gents, and disabled toilets. The thermostat is in the lobby, on the wall near the entrance to the ladies toilet. It is preset on a schedule to keep the areas from becoming too cold.

If you require the temperature to be increased, drop the flap down on the thermostat and press the “BOOST” button as indicated 2x for a 1 hour boost in temperature.

Please do not use the door curtain heater above the entrance door, which requires a new fan



Side Rooms / Back Room Air Conditioning

The side rooms are equipped with highly efficient air-source heat pumps, which can provide both heating and cooling. They are configured on a schedule at 20°C in ‘AUTO’ so will heat or cool according to need.

TO USE: Each room has a remote control mounted on the wall which can be used to turn on/off the units, and to adjust the temperature up and down. The temperature is displayed on the wall mounted unit.

The top middle button (looks like two arrows) changes the mode between Auto, Heat, Cool, Dry etc, best left on Auto.

If you turn the unit on, please switch off again before you leave.
